you ...

Jean: And blasted off in her wardrobe to find out where fabrics come from...

Hazel: ...Armchair Adventures Style!

# SFX Wardrobe blasting off

Connie: We visited a wool farm and learnt about looking after the sheep so they

give us their fleece every year to make wool...

### SFX baaaa of sheep

Walter: And a cotton farm and saw how to protect the soil to help the cotton

plants grow.

### SFX Growing sounds

Steve: Yewoch! It's pin the tail on the donkey not the Steve!

Cyril: Whoops, sorry!

Pauline: Hurry up with the re-cap Connie you're missing all the birthday party

games!

Lily: Let's play musical statues next!

Connie: But I got a bit worried about ordering my new prom dress in time from a

fast fashion website...

#### SFX Dress notification

Lynda: ...and we didn't know where the fabrics it was made of came from...

Hazel: So, Amy took us underground to learn about fossil fuels...

Keith: Here we met an oil monster.... and we were all a bit scared...

### SFX Oil monster

Connie: But it turns out he was really friendly!

Amy: And that it was his 256 millionth birthday!

Connie: So, we decided to give him an underground birthday party. Come on

everyone let's play musical statues! When the music stops you have to

freeze!

#### Customers excited to play

You too adventurers!

## SFX Ding then music playing with a freeze

Adventurer: I'm throwing some shapes

Adventurer: FREEZE!

Adventurer: I can't hold this pose

Adventurer: I'm going to win

Adventurer: You moved!

Adventurer: No I didn't

Adventurer: Wow, Oily that's a cool pose

Oil: Thank you for a great party, Connie!

#### SFX Dress notification

Connie: No problem! Do you know what everyone, forget about this new plastic

oil dress, I'm going to go sustainable and wear my mum's prom dress.

The customers and oil all congratulate connie.

Keith: There's still one item in the wardrobe we haven't learnt about too, the

pants made of trees!

Amy: Then there's only one thing for it! Back in the wardrobe everyone... I

think I'm getting the hang of this journey of the imagination magic

Connie...

Connie: Me too Amy, lovely to meet you, Oil.

Oil: Come back soon!

Amy: Is everyone in?

Customers - affirmative!

Pat: Then hold on to these pants and let's find out where they come from!

SFX Wardrobe blasting off.

#### Scene 7

SFX Woodland atmosphere, birds tweeting, bugs humming, trees swaying in the

breeze.

Pauline: What a beautiful forest!

Walter: The gentle breeze on your face.

Anne: All the animals and wildlife rushing around...

Customers enjoying the forest...

Connie: It's so green and peaceful, what can you see in the forest adventurers?

SFX Ding

Adventurer: Lots of bugs buzzing around

Adventurer: Squirrels running in the trees!

Adventurer: There's lots of beautiful flowers and plants

Adventurer: It's beautiful here

#### SFX Squirrel

Anne: Look at that little red squirrel, it looks like it wants us to follow it...

Amy: Let's see where it's going everyone...

Anne: It looks like it wants to tell us something

Cyril: Hello squirrel!

Customers all agree.

Keith: It's showing us its lovely home in this big old tree.

Hazel: It's quite high up...

Connie: That's so cool, but what's that buzzing sound in the distance?

SFX tree cutting in the distance.

Connie: I'm going to climb up this tree with the squirrel and find out...

Lily: Be careful Connie!

\*Promo swap\*

Connie: While I make my way up the tree, Let's pause our journey of the

imagination. There's something I'd like you to listen to. It's

another podcast I think you'd enjoy...

Advert plays

Connie: Welcome back adventurers. Let's get back to the forest...

\*Promo swap ends\*

## SFX tree climbing

John O'G: Can you see anything Connie?

Connie: Oh no gang, there's people in the distance cutting down the trees! We

have to stop it; we can't let them take this squirrel's home!

Customers concerned

We need to protest; this is not sustainable!

Let's make some placards to protest with! Mine will say 'hands off our

trees!' What would yours say adventurers!

# SFX Ding

Adventurer: Save the trees!

Adventurer: Nature first

Adventurer: Save the animals!

Adventurer: Don't hurt nature

Connie: These are great! Now we need a chant so all those work people cutting

down the trees can hear us! After me Adventurers - Save the trees,

save the trees!

## SFX Ding

Adventurers: Save the trees, save the trees!

SFX Connie and adventurers chant to underscore

Pat: Hang on Connie, I think the squirrel is trying to tell us something...

SFX squirrel sounds

Connie: It's not working adventurers they are still cutting down the tress...

SFX tree saw.

Connie: It's time for more action! Let's chain ourselves to the trees, come on

everyone, there's no time to waste!

Pat: Connie wait!

Cyril: Slow down!

Customers trying to get her to stop for a second.

Anne: The squirrel is pointing upwards,

Amy: Were on an armchair adventure, maybe it's trying to tell us something?

Pat: Climb a bit higher Connie

SFX Squirrel

Connie: Ok Squirrel friend, I'll come and see. You too adventurers pretend climb

the tree with me!

SFX Ding

Adventurer: Uh oh – it's very high up!

Adventurer: I can see a bird in the nest

Adventurer: I'm scared of heights!

Adventurer: Wow you can see so far up here

SFX Squirrel

Ronnie: Any news Connie?

Connie: (Shouting down) Well, in place of the trees they cut down the workers

are planting new ones...

Pat: Well that's good news?

Connie: Maybe, but they will take ages to grow, I still don't want them to cut

down this squirrel's home...

Amy: The part of the forest we're in is protected Connie. That means the

workers you can see can't cut any of it down. They have agreed to only use the land they are working on and that they have to replace what

they take by planting new trees.

Connie: Oh I see, I suppose that is a good way of doing things.

Amy: Why don't we go and help them plant some new trees and find out

more.

Connie: Ok Amy, let's do it.

Pat: Come on everyone, let's go and help the workers plant new trees!

Hazel: Yes please, I love gardening!

Pauline: Last one there's a rotten egg!

Customers all running off laughing.

Connie: Wait for me, everyone! Down I go...weeeee!

SFX sliding down the tree and running followed by planting atmosphere.

Hazel: Ok, first tree sapling going in...

Lynda: Another one planted over here!

Jean: So, do all people who farm trees for fabric replace them like this Amy?

Amy: If only, the majority of trees that are cut down are never replaced, that's

why, if we can, it's even better to reuse what we already have instead

of making new things.

SFX dig and plant sounds

Cyril: That's another tree planted!

Pat: So, more shopping at charity shops?

John O'G: Or swapping clothes with friends?

Amy: Definitely, or repairing what we have and recycling the fabrics that

already exist into new clothes.

Connie: So all the places we have visited are the best way of making new

things, but we should try and use what we already have?

Amy: Spot on Connie! Trees are so important for the environment we should

limit the amount we take, because as you said, they take a really long

time to grow back.

Connie: Thanks everyone! I've learnt so much on our adventure so far. It's

important for me to wear my mum's prom dress...even though it really,

really, really doesn't suit me...

Pauline: Oh I'm sure it's not that bad Connie...

here!

Customers are up for it.

SFX everyone unpicking the dress and mucking in
